- a. Direct exam conducted by Greg Conner
 - i. Audio interview continuation:
 1. Brian Walshe is heard saying that Ana had moved her schedule. [1:30-3:10]
 - a. Brian says that Ana has booked a flight to return on January and says that she was going to come on Thursday night and stay until Monday. [2:30-3:05]
 2. Brian Walshe is heard saying that he would "never do that" when asked if he would hurt his wife. [12:00-12:55] - [word choice - wife instead of ana]
 - a. He says would never do anything to hurt his wife and she is the mother of her children.
 3. Brian Walshe is heard saying that Ana was angry on thanksgiving about not spending time with Ana as she was away from the boys and he was away from the wife. [13:00-13:50] Angry thanksgiving
 - a. He says both him and Ana agreed to work together in DC [13:34-13:50]
 4. Brian Walshe is heard describing a conflict that happened two years ago in Serbia over a land where Ana's father's and grandmother bought a piece of land with her sister and the land had a lot value which he described as life changing. [22:30-24:50] Serbia land dispute
 - a. Brian says they were fighting over it and thought they were going to resolve it in 2017 but that didn't happen and five years later they couldn't resolve it.
 - b. Brian says he cant think of anyone that would hurt Ana when asked if he knew of anyone who would want to harm Ana.
 - ii. The judge read out emails that were agreed by both parties as stipulated fact . [31:18-33:40]
 1. Email 1: timestamped 5:18am, Saturday 7th 2023 Harrison Schimdt received an email from richardwalker9984@gmail.com which stated "We have the so-named Anna Walshe with us here. We had a deal worth \$127,000. She messed up. We have her here with us and if she doesn't pay the money, then she will never be back and we know that the police and the FBI are involved. Good luck finding us

2. Email 2: [no timestamp was provided], [same email address as email 1] which stated "Here is Anna Walshe. Unless she the money we deal, she isn't coming back. Thanks and good luck. [32:00-32:30]
 - a. The judge stipulated that "the email contain an image of a woman who was not Anna Walshe and using an image search, the police found the image on istockphoto.com under quote kidnapped stock photos end quote". [32:30-32:35]
3. The judge stipulated that "on 7th January 2023, the police obtained a search warrant for data associated with the account richardwalker9984@gmail.com. Search warrant was sent to google and investigators learned that the internet protocol address, the IP address with the richardwalker9984 email account geolocated to Nigeria and no IP addresses located in the United States were associated with the account that sent the richardwalker9984@gmail.com email." [32:40-33:25]
- iii. Harrison Schimdt testifies to the missing poster of Ana Walshe where he says he made it on Thursday after he spoke with the defendant. [36:05-37:05]
- iv. Harrison Schimdt testifies to the 2nd interview with Michael Proctor and David Dicicco conducted on Sunday, 8th January 2023 at 11:13am. Tracey Miner, Brian Walshe's attorney was also present. [40:10-47:12]
 1. When asked to explain the search at 4:54 on his ipad on ways to dispose a body, Brian says Thomas [his son] would use it and he doesn't know how that got there. [44:55-47:05] Explanation of searches
 - a. When asked to explain more searches regarding other searches, saying he doesn't know.
- v. Harrison Schimdt testifies to arresting Brian Walshe at 4pm on 8th January 2022. [47:20-47:55]
- vi. Harrison Schimdt testifies to the photos on the cuts on Brian's thumbs when he was arrested. [48:18-49:00]
- vii. Harrison Schimdt testifies to conducting searching the bags of thrash at the SERT team warehouse with Lieutenant Tully and Lieutenant Lobes *Kohasa* [name may not be accurate] [49:20-52:10]
 1. Contents such as hunter boots and the white piece of paper with the name Ana Walsh on it was retrieved from the thrash bags.
- viii. Harrison Schimdt testifies to Ana Walshe's financial information [52:40-1:01:00]
 1. Jet Blue card had no financial activity on January 1st 2022 but a total of \$2,046.69 and 5,057 financial activity for the December period.
 2. United flight was purchased on 30th October 2022 for 23rd November 2022, From Airport Code IED to Airport Code DUB. [56:20-58:00]
 - a. Air France flight was purchased on the same day. Departing Airport Code DUB to Arrival Airport code CDG.
 - i. Connecting flight Airport Code CDG to Airport code to Airport code BEG for 27th November 2027.
 3. Lustana Airlines for the date 7th December 2022, departing Airport code BEG to Airport code FRA.
 - a. Connecting flight airport code FRA to Airport code BOS.

4. Harrison Schimdt testifies to the airport codes:
 - a. BOS = Boston Logan
 - b. IED = Dallas in Virginia
 - c. DUB= Dublin, Ireland
 - d. CDG= Charles de Gaul, France
 - e. BEG= Belgrade
 - f. FRA= Frankfurt.
 5. Harrison Schimdt testifies to credit cards information belonging to Ana Walshe [58:00-59:30]
 - a. He testifies to \$2690.97 being owed on the IHG rewards card.
 - i. He testifies to the closing date for the account being 23rd January 2023.
 6. Harrison Schmidt testifies to the saving and investment accounts information belonging to Ana Walshe. [59:30-1:01:00] [Incentive]
 - a. He testifies to the balance of the statement ending 31st January 2023 on her Liberty Bay Credit Union Statement being \$3,388.98.
 - i. Withdrawals:
 1. 3rd January 2023 = \$87.00, MLS property, recurring every three months
 2. 3rd January 2023 = \$236.00, WJ management, recurring monthly.
 3. 4th January 2023 = \$209.35, Great North prop., recurring monthly.
 - b. He testifies to the IRA investment account from 1st February 2023 to 28th February 2023
 - i. He testifies to the value of the account being \$93,615.82
 - c. He testifies to the individual investment account from 1st February 2023 to 28th February 2023
 - i. He testifies to the value of the account being \$117,719.74
 - ix. The Judge read a stipulated fact agreed to by both parties: [1:01:20-1:03:06]
 1. "Brian Walshe was arraigned in United States District Court in Boston, Massachusetts on 11th May 2018.
 2. On 1st April 2021, Brian Walshe pled Guilty to Indictments of Wire fraud, interstate transportation or a scheme to defraud and conducting an unlawful monetary transaction.
 3. On 6th October 2021, an initial sentencing hearing took place in the United States District court. Brian Walshe was seeking a sentence of probation and restitution, whilst the United States Attorney's office was seeking a sentence, which included incarceration of 30 to 37 months and restitution of approximately \$475,000.
 4. In January 2023, Brian Walshe had not been sentenced on the federal charges. Brian Walsh was represented by a lawyer at all stages of the federal case.
- b. Cross exam conducted by Larry Tipton
- i. Harrison Schmidt testifies to the records shown on direct exam does not show any withdraws made by Brian Walshe. [1:03:45-1:04:50] - [Removes incentive]

1. Harrison Schmidt testifies to not finding any of the financial records at Brian Walshe home nor in Brian Walshe's possession. [1:04:05-1:04:30]
 - ii. Harrison Schmidt testifies to Brian Walshe being forthcoming about his federal case to police and has no outstanding Federal cases.
 - iii. Harrison Schmidt testifies to Brian Walshe never using his son's Ipad Mini to conduct those searches and accepted his demeanour changed and he looked sad. 1:09:30-1:11:50]
 - iv. Harrison Schmidt testifies to being unaware of any digital forensics of Brian Walshe seeing messages between William Fastow and Ana Walshe. [1:24:14-1:27:50]
 - v. Harrison Schimdt testifies to Brian Walshe not saying anything pejorative about William Fastow when asked questions about him.
 - vi. Harrison Schmidt testifies to warning Brian Walshe about people suspecting during their interview. [1:31:20-1:34:50]
- c. No redirect exam was conducted

Established with Harrison Schimdt's testimony

Ana Walshe had booked flights to travel from 23rd November 2022 from Dallas in Virginia airport to Dublin Ireland.

Ana Walshe had booked flights to travel from 27th November 2022 from Dublin, Ireland to Belgrade, Serbia.

Ana Walshe had booked flights to travel from 7th December 2022 from Belgrade, Serbia to Frankfurt.

Brian Walshe declares he would never hurt his wife in police interview and do not know about the google searches.

Harrison Schmidt received emails from an email located in Nigeria regarding having knowledge of Ana Walshe's whereabouts.

Lack of knowledge regarding Brian Walshe witnessing messages between William Fastow and Ana Walshe.

- viii. Nicholas Guarino testifies to Brian's iPhone mini 13 device activity when it was used on 1st January and 2nd January 2023 [1:28:20-
 1. Phone device activity 1st January 2023 [1:32:10-1:35:00]
 - a. Phone was unlocked on 7:57am for 2 minutes.
 - i. Phone was locked on 7:59am
 - b. Phone was plugged in and was charging 2 seconds later on 8:09:12am.
 - c. Phone was unlocked on 11:23am.
 - i. Phone was locked on 11:24:15am
 - d. Phone was unlocked on 12:38:40am
 - i. Phone was locked on 12:39:20am
 - e. Phone was unlocked on 12:45:20pm
 - i. Phone was locked on 12:46:49pm

 - a. Phone was unlocked on 2:25pm
- ix. Nicholas Guarino testifies to transporting the 7 bags of rug, metal tissue and hair that was collected to the crime lab and submitted for processing where he received a receipt and created a report.

b. Cross Exam conducted by Larry Tipton

- i. Nicholas Guarino testifies to the cheating wife testimony on the Scarlett scandal and it was not a google search but likely a Pornhub search that cant be verified in the records. [7:20-15:25]
 1. He testifies he cant view the search terms inputted in the Pornhub search bar, only on google can he view. [8:40-9:34]
 2. He testifies to not perusing the Pornhub site or video. [9:37-11:15]
 - a. Nicholas Guarino testifies to the video being viewed for 7 minutes and not having an idea whether the person was just watching their series. [10:35-11:15]
 3. He testifies to not taking the time to see what the movie was about or the actress in the movie. [12:30-12:45]
 - a. Nicholas Guarino testifies to focusing on the "cheating wife" phrase on direct exam. [14:00-15:15]
 - i. He testifies that Pornhub was visited 12 times and not sure if it is the entire web history because he did not go to look further. [14:50-15:15]
- ii. Nicholas Guarino testifies to the divorce only occurred from 27th December 2022 and if there are any other searches before 25th December 2022, he wouldn't know. [19:00-24:00]
 1. He testifies to seeing Zillow searches in the Macbook for apartments in the DC area but is not aware of any sales. [21:00-23:00]
 - a. Nicholas Guarino testifies that there were no texts between Brian Walsh and Anna Walsh encompassing the dates of 25th December 2022 and 30th December 2022 from his search.
 2. He testifies to not recalling any documents about or related to divorce associated with the divorce searches.
- iii. Nicholas Guarino testifies to not searching to see what the results would be for this specific search when asked that the results would bring up different results. [30:00-35:40]
 1. He testifies to needing to get a probable cause warrant to examine how to get rid of a body searches prior to 1st January 2023 4:45am [33:30-35:40]
 - a. Nicholas Guarino testifies to choosing to limit the search to 12:15 pm 8th January 2023 and did not see anything in the data dating back to 25 December 2022. [34:50-35:40]
 - i. He testifies to there being no searches about DNA or anything about the soil; how to get rid of blood; hydrogen peroxide to clean up blood and he could not see these searches prior to 1st January 2023.
 2. He testiifies to having no recollection about discussing with the Commonwealth about searches specific to William Fastow. [37:00-37:30]
